

## Aava Mobile Policy for Responsible Minerals Procurement

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Oulu, 1<sup>st</sup> of March 2020

Aava Mobile is committed for responsible procurement of material.

Procurement of notably tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold and cobalt from states in conflict areas and other high-risk areas carries with it a risk of funding organizations that are involved in all kinds of illegal or unethical activities including human rights abuses such as child labor, harsh working conditions, environmental destruction and corruption.

Aava Mobile utilizes specialized 3rd party consultants to collect the data in accordance with the OECD due diligence guidelines. This includes surveying the supply chain to identify the smelters used and eliminating the use of suspicious materials within the supply chain.

Our objective is to have a conflict-free supply chain. Aava Mobile doesn't directly source any minerals but always uses well known component suppliers with proven responsibility policy. If Aava becomes aware of a supplier whose supply chain includes metals from a conflict source, Aava will take the appropriate actions to remedy the situation in a timely manner, including reassessment of supplier relationships, to achieve that objective.
